

2021 NJAS HEALTH REGULATIONS

For exhibition only and then returning to origin:

- Official identification for all animals over 18 months of age recorded on the CVI. No testing required for beef animals except for a few counties in Michigan.
- No BVD-pi test is required for NJAS.
- Need statement “Exhibition only, returning to origin.”

For animals that may come to Nebraska and stay in Nebraska after the show:

- Official identification for animals over 18 months AND any breeding stock over 6 months of age recorded on the CVI
- Trichomoniasis statement required for breeding stock.

Any animals from outside the borders of the US or that have traveled outside of the US will require a permit. Refer to the office information below for permit inquiries.
